



On April 26, ATH organized the final presentation of the FUFA project in Dwingeloo. The FUFA project (Familiarisation for the Utilisation of Flat Antennas) is a PEP-financed project to familiarise with ESA programs. For FUFA, this familiarisation was focussed on an ESA ARTES-5 project called Advanced Antenna Concepts for Aircraft In Flight Entertainment. This project studies Ku-band (11GHz) phased array antenna systems for aircrafts to allow the passengers access to, among others, live television and internet using geostationary satellites.
